**Rules:**

**Open Doubles applies the Rules of Curling for General Play, as approved by Curling Canada with the following exceptions:**

- 1) Each team is comprised of two curlers. Any combination of male or female, regular or stick curler.
- 2) One member of each team stays at opposite ends. The team losing the opening coin toss will choose if players will switch sides after four ends. If they choose to switch, then they decide which team will switch ends or both.
- 3) The two delivering curlers alternately throw six stones each per end. All games are eight ends.
- 4) Sweeping/brushing is only allowed after the hog lines.
- 5) Rocks cannot be removed from play. If that happens, the delivered stone is removed and stones taken out of play returned to their original positions.
- 6) In case of a tie, draw to button (no sweeping).
